The petitioner-Kamaldeep Singh, seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.187, dated 20.11.2016, under sections 420, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner has been in custody since 04.07.2017. The investigation is complete and one prosecution witness has also been examined, that apart it is also submitted that petitioner has been wrongly implicated. It was Gurkirpal Singh, who had promised the job and issued cheques worth Rs.16 lacs in favour of the complainant as is evident from the police file. It is conclusively established that the petitioner had not taken any amount.

3. Learned State counsel does not dispute this fact that the investigation has revealed that Gurkirpal Singh had issued cheques worth Rs.16 lacs to the

complainant and the same were dishonoured on presentation.

4. In view of the above and keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances of this case, it would be just and appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

5. Thus, the petition is allowed. Petitioner- Kamaldeep Singh son of late Sh. Manmohan Singh, is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Gurdaspur.
