The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.86 dated 27.12.2011, registered under Sections 420, 34 IPC at Police Station Shapur Kandi, District Gurdaspur (now Pathankot).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has resigned from the company on 03.12.2009 vide Form No.32 (Annexure P-2) and the transactions were made thereafter.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gobind Parsad, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 06.09.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
