This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 326, 323, 341, 148, 149, 120-B IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, vide FIR No.354 dated 13.12.2014.

FIR was registered on complaint of one Jasvir Singh. Allegations are that a land dispute is going on between complainant and Satnam Singh, father of accused. On 11.12.2014, after attending hearing of the case, Satnam Singh asked complainant to compromise the matter, but he declined his proposal. On the same day at about 6.00 P.M., accused Amarjit Singh (petitioner herein) armed with *Gandasa*, his father Satnam Singh having a *Kappa*, Gagan Singh alias Bobby armed with *Dandas*, Balwinder Singh alias Godhi armed with *Danda* came and attacked the complainant.

On the instigation of Satnam Singh, accused inflicted injuries with their respective weapons. Petitioner also inflicted *Gandasa* blow on the head of the complainant and when complainant raised his hand to rescue himself, it hit his right wrist, resulting into its amputation. Co-accused Balwinder Singh also gave *Danda* blows to the complainant.

Keeping in view the nature of crime and the punishment it would entail in case of conviction, I am of the considered view that petitioner is not entitled to concession of bail at this stage.

Dismissed.
