Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.268, dated 28.07.2016, registered under Sections 409, 420 IPC, at Police Station Madlauda, District Panipat.

This is the second petition as earlier petition filed by petitioner i.e. CRM-M No.24181 of 2017 was dismissed on 11.07.2017. On 14.05.2018, case was adjourned on request of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner has been declared PO vide order dated 30.03.2018 and challan has also been presented against one accused.

Keeping in view the fact that petitioner has been declared PO, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail.
