Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for issuance of directions to respondents no.2 and 3 to take action on representation dated 04.09.2017, as submitted by the petitioners, wherein a prayer has been made for registration of FIR against respondents no.4 and 5 for commission of offences, as pleaded.

Learned State counsel, while referring to status report submitted by way of affidavit of R.N. Dhoke, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, has drawn attention of this Court to para 4 of the same, wherein FIR No.169 dated 21.08.2016 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, Police Station Sahnewal, Ludhiana has already been registered against respondents no.4 and 5, on the complaint of one Mastaan Singh, for committing fraud under the garb of selling land of the respondents no.4 and

5 – company and the petitioners have been arrayed as victims at the hands of respondents no.4 and 5. Even the statements of the petitioners have also been recorded under Section 161 CrPC. Thus, the prayer of the petitioners for registration of case against respondents no.4 and 5 has duly been responded in the aforesaid affidavit.

In view of the specific averments made in the affidavit of the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, the prayer of the petitioner stands meticulously met with.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
