Prayer in the above-mentioned petitions under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of DDR No. 48 (cross version case), dated 21.04.2014, registered under Sections 382/427 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, at P.S. Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural (Annexure P/1) and FIR No. 85 (version case), dated 21.04.2014, registered under Sections 323/341/506/148/149 IPC (Annexure P/3), at P.S. Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural, on the basis of compromise dated 16.09.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 30.01.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 08.02.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Amritsar, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.72, dated 23.02.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar, vide Endst. No.1799R, dated 22.02.2018.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Amritsar, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with their free will.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Amritsar, dated 23.02.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, DDR No. 48 (cross version case), dated 21.04.2014, registered under Sections 382/427 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, at P.S. Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural (Annexure P/1) and FIR No. 85 (version case), dated 21.04.2014, registered under Sections 323/341/506/148/149 IPC (Annexure P/3), at P.S. Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural, are quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, in each case out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
