By way of filing this petition the petitioner seeks issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.3 to 5 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in respect of FIR No.617 dated 08.12.2017 under Sections 380, 457 Indian Penal Code, 1860 Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel has submitted that the complainant had lodged the FIR in question against the accused who trespassed into his shop forcibly and had taken away the articles lying in the shop and although the FIR was lodged eight months back but no headway has been made in the investigation so far.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and also bearing in mind the fact that the FIR was lodged way back in the year 2017, the

respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra is directed to look into the matter and to ensure that the matter is fairly and impartially investigated and a final report under Section 173 Criminal Procedure Code is submitted expeditiously.
