The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.560 dated 21.06.2018 registered under Sections 148, 324, 326, 452, 427, 506 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Moden Town, Panipat.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are in custody since 24.06.2018 and 26.06.2018. They are not required for any investigation purposes. It is further contended that there have been inconsistency in the claim qua the injuries caused to the injured because two different MLRs have been placed on record through two different FIRs of the same date. It is further contended that except these two FIRs, there is no case against the petitioners. Counsel also contends that the co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted bail.

On the other hand, counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Dalbir, submits that injury attributed to Sunil has been declared to be grievous. It is further contended that the petitioners have committed serious

offence, therefore, they should not be released on bail.

However, keeping in view the above submissions made by counsel for the petitioners, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioners be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
