This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149, 342 IPC at Police Station, Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran vide F.I.R No. 60 dated 27.7.2016.

Pursuant to order dated 9.10.2017, petitioners appeared before the Investigating officer. Learned State counsel, however, points out that injury attracting offence under Section 326 was caused by Baljinder Singh-petitioner No.3. This injury was caused by sharp edge weapon and resulted in fracture of right arm of Manjit Singh.

I am of the considered view that accused-Baljinder Singh is not entitled to concession of bail. Dismissed qua him. According to State counsel, rest of the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation may not be necessary.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 9.10.2017 is hereby made absolute qua petitioner Nos. 1 & 2, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed qua petitioner Nos. 1 & 2 in aforesaid terms.
