This is 3rd petition of the petitioner for grant of concession of anticipatory bail in criminal case No. 45 of 21.11.2011 under Section 302/201 read with Section 34 IPC.

2. Petitioner had filed his 1st anticipatory bail petition i.e. CRM-32812 of 2018 which was disposed of on 02.08.2018 with the following order:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid."

Thereafter, he has presented 2nd bail petition CRM-M-33820-2018 dated 13.08.2018 which reads as under:-

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed as withdrawn."

3. Now petitioner has presented this petition. While deciding CRM-M-33820-2018 on 13.08.2018 matter was heard at length. When the anticipatory petition was about to be dismissed at that juncture learned counsel for the petitioner sought for withdrawal of the petition as it was dismissed as withdrawn. In this background, present petition is filed. As no fresh ground is urged in the present petition to seek relief and offence is relating to murder. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
