The petitioner prays for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take appropriate action upon his representation dated 01.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel has submitted that the petitioner is a young widow having three minor children and after death of her husband she has been staying with her parents along with her brother and sister-in-law. However, in order to look for a suitable job she went to Delhi without informing anybody but now she is being threatened by her brother and father and they are not allowing her to return back.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-1) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest. It is further directed that in case, there is any genuine apprehension of threat to life and liberty of the petitioner, then adequate steps be taken so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-1) be sent to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
