This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 379/411 IPC at Police Station Chhehharta, District Amritsar City, vide FIR No.237 dated 05.10.2017.

Petitioner is stated to be in custody since 7.10.2017. It has been urged before the court that petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the basis of suspicion. Admittedly, no witness has been examined till now. No useful purpose would, thus, be served by detaining him any longer. Accordingly, petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to such terms and conditions as trial court may deem fit to impose.

As the petitioner is stated to be a habitual offender, State shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of bail in case any such situation arises.
