This petition has been filed by petitioner Gurmail Singh under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.66 dated 26.08.2017 under Sections 121-A, 286, 436, 109, 120-B IPC (Section 188 IPC added later on) and Sections 3 and 4 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 registered at Police Station S. G. N. Dev Thermal Plant, Bathinda (Section 121-A IPC was deleted vide Rapat No.3 dated 14.10.2017).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is having small children and he is follower of the Dera for the last three generations.

Admittedly, earlier the petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing CRM-M No.3681 of 2018, which was dismissed as withdrawn

vide order dated 24.05.2018. Neither there is any changed circumstance nor any new ground has been made out to grant anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view the fact that the second petition is not maintainable when the earlier petition has been dismissed without any changed circumstances, accordingly the present petition being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and moves an application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to consider the same and pass necessary order in accordance with law within a period of two weeks thereafter.
