In the present petition, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.56 dated 05.07.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Ghuman, Police Distt. District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned State counsel on instructions of H.C.Kulwinder Singh submitted that having regard to the nature of offences and there is a proposal for compromise among the petitioner and the 2nd respondent read with age of the petitioner who seems to be a senior citizen, petitioner is entitled for anticipatory bail.

Petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation.

In the event of his appearance, Investigating Officer shall release him on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to its entire satisfaction. He shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
