The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case First Information Report No.0221 dated 08.08.2017 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of order dated 18.01.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel. On instructions from ASI Kirpal Singh, he submits that Section 201 of the Indian Penal Code has also been added

against the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 18.01.2018 is made
absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
