The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 392 dated 19.09.2017 under Section 13(2) of HGS & GS Act, 2015 and Sections 11/59/60 of Prevention of Animal Cruelty Act, 1960, registered at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh.

The operative part of the order dated 07.09.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner, who is aged about 67 years, had jumped from the truck and ran away and he could not be apprehended by the police party. It is further submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case and no recovery is to be effected from him. Notice of motion for 26.11.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 07.09.2018, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Attar Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 07.09.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
