In the instant petition, petitioner has sought regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.91 dated 22.4.2016 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

Petitioner was arrested on 22.4.2016 and he is in jail since then. There are no reasons forth-coming as to why the trial has not been completed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner repeatedly stated that the petitioner has no other case to his credit. The matter was adjourned for this purpose to enable the State counsel to verify on two occasions but there is no report.

With the liberty reserved in favour of the State counsel to point out any other case against the petitioner, I am inclined to grant bail.

Accordingly, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall surrender his passport if

possesses with the Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

The petitioner shall not influence or tamper with the prosecution witnesses.
