RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing the Complaint No. SC 233 of 2015 dated 16.08.2013 (Annexure P-1), filed under Sections 308, 323, 325, 447, 427, 379, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC, titled as ***Hari Ram vs. Janak Ram and others***, pending in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Mansa and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 24.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 07.09.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Additional Sessions

Judge, Mansa and got recorded their statements qua compromise on 20.09.2018. Report from the Additional Sessions Judge, Mansa, vide letter No. 950 dated 21.09.2018, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Mansa, vide Endst. No. 5473, Dated 24.09.2018, has been received. According to the report of the Additional Sessions Judge, Mansa, the compromise is genuine and it is voluntarily effected between the parties with their free consent and without any pressure, threat, coercion or undue influence from any side.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid Complaint No. SC 233 of 2015 dated 16.08.2013 (Annexure P-1), filed under Sections 308, 323, 325, 447, 427, 379, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC, titled as ***Hari Ram vs. Janak Ram and others***, pending in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Mansa and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana, High Court, Rs. 1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with High Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
