This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 307, 506, 420, 34 IPC and 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station, City Sangrur vide FIR No.250 dated 1.8.2017.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he alongwith Saghar Singh and Beant Singh extracted money from the son of the complainant on the pretext of getting him a job in the police department. As nothing materialised, Surinderpal Singh demanded that his amount be returned. However, accused threatened to eliminate him. On the day of occurrence Saghar Singh caused him injury with gunshot in the presence of other accused including the petitioner. The injured was taken to PGI where it transpired that injury was on the head of the injured with metallic object. During the course of arguments, it has been stated by State counsel that petitioner is involved in seven other cases. Besides, despite two opportunities granted to him, he has failed to join investigation. Prayer for anticipatory bail is thus misconceived. Petition is hereby dismissed.
