By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend threats to the same at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that all the 4 petitioners are commission agents and are partners and that the private respondents No.4 to 6 owe some amount to the petitioners and to repay the said amount they had issued cheques which have been dishonoured regarding which the petitioners have filed separate complaints under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. Learned counsel has submitted that the private respondents in order to escape from their liability are pressurizing the petitioners and have been filing false complaints against

them and that the petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of the aforesaid respondents.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga (respondent No.3) to look into the matter and to ensure that the petitioners are not unnecessarily harassed. In case, it is found that there is any apprehension or threat to life and liberty of the petitioners, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

A copy of this order along with copy of petition be sent to respondent No.3 immediately so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
