JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
seeking quashing of FIR No. 64 dated 15.10.2013 under Sections 498-A &
406 IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits
that the matter stood compromised between the complainant, namely
Sarbjee Kaur, respondent No.2 and petitioner Nos. 1, 3 & 4 and FIR against
them has already been quashed by this Court on 31.07.2018 in a petition
CRM-M-22334-2018 titled 'Mukhtiar Singh and others vs. State of Punjab
and another'.

In view of the fact that the FIR and the subsequent proceedings
arising thereunder already stands quashed in the aforesaid petition, no

further orders are called for in the instant case as regards petitioner Nos. 1, 3 & 4.

A reading of the FIR would also indicate that no specific role has been attributed to petitioner No.2 and there is only a passing reference to her. She has been named in the FIR on the ground that the husband wanted to marry her. Since the main dispute already stands settled with the husband and in-laws, no useful purpose would be achieved. Hence, FIR qua petitioner No.2 stands quashed as well.

Petition stands allowed.
