This petition was filed by Baljinder Singh and his wife Sukhjinder Kaur (petitioner No.2) on apprehension of threat at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and had prayed for protection of their life and liberty.

A representation was also given to the SSP, Fatehgarh Sahib revealing the reasons and apprehension so founded by the applicants (petitioners). It is claimed in the representation that the petitioners after marriage were living happily and petitioner No.2 namely Sukhjinder Kaur, who had lost her father had tried to sell the property belonging to her but the private respondents were against it as her mother Sandeep Kaur had married with Surinder Singh i.e. respondent No.6.

In response to the notice of motion order issued by this Court, reply has been filed on behalf of the official respondents No.1 to 3 indicating that as on today, there is no threat and the statement of petitioner No.2 is also recorded in that regard, which is placed on record as Annexure

R-1. As per her statement, she has entered into a compromise with her

brother-Gurwinder Singh and she and her husband do not wish to pursue this issue any further.

In view of this, petition is rendered infructuous.
