Petitioner-Pankaj has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.609 dated 12.09.2017, registered at Police Station Hansi City, District Hisar, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 452, 307, 427 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Vikas Malik, DAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that neither the present petitioner is named in the FIR, nor any specific injury has been attributed to him. Even during the investigation, injuries by 10-15 boys have been stated to be caused to Rajesh, but as per learned State counsel, there are only five injuries on the person of Rajesh. Four injuries are already specifically mentioned in the FIR.

The petitioner has been in custody since 18.09.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
