JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is the petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.191 dated 17.05.2017, under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Zirakpur.

The Addl. Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar Mohali, had dismissed the bail application, while noting that the dowry articles that had been recovered, were fake. Notice of motion was issued on 11.10.2017 on a submission made that the petitioner is ready to settle the dispute amicably either by way of rehabilitation or by a one time settlement. The parties were directed to be present in the court on the next date of hearing, however,

despite several opportunities having been availed of by the counsel for the petitioner to ensure the presence of the petitioner in court in terms of the offer made to have the matter settled amicably, it appears that the petitioner is willfully not complying with the said orders.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
