Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.12, dated 09.11.2017, under Section 3 of Railway Property (unlawful Possession) Act, 1966, registered at Police Station R.P.F., Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that two co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted concession of regular bail vide order dated 19.01.2018 passed in CRM-M-48529-2017 titled as Bijender Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and vide order dated 02.02.2018 passed in CRM-M-1253-2018 titled as Jitender Arora Vs. State of Haryana. It is further submitted that the investigation is complete and challan has already been presented on 10.01.2018.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial lock up since 13.11.2017; challan has been presented and conclusion of the trial will take long time and the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate, this petition is allowed and

the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his
furnishing bail /surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa
Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition disposed of.
