By invoking Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has prayed for quashing of FIR No.98 dated 13.08.2013 for offence punishable under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered with Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 27.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.
