The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.83 dated 26.08.2018, registered under Sections 153/153-A/295-A IPC and 66(F) of Information Technology Act, at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 10.09.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
