By this petition, quashing of FIR No.69 dated 17.07.2017, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 363/366/148/149 IPC, is sought, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners (accused) and respondent no.3 (complainant).

Vide an order of this Court dated 08.12.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the concerned trial Court to get their statements recorded, in terms of the compromise.

Pursuant to the order dated 08.12.2017, the report of the learned JMIC, Batala, has been received stating to the effect that the statement of respondent no.3, Amritpal Kaur, was recorded before that Court, which has been appended with the report itself.

A perusal thereof shows that it has been stated by the aforesaid

respondent that she has married petitioner no.1, Tejbir Singh, on 12.10.2016, against the wishes of her parents but of her own free will and that she has never been abducted or kidnapped by any person.

As per the copy of her Aadhar card, which has also annexed with the report, the year of birth shown to be is 1990, thereby making her about 27-28 years of age.

That being so and the matter also stated to have been compromised between the petitioners and respondent no.2, who is stated to be the mother of respondent no.3 (complainant in the FIR in question), the petition is allowed and FIR No.69 dated 17.07.2017, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 363/366/148/149 IPC, alongwith all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
