Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.300 dated 20.07.2018 under Sections 7/10/55 of Essential Commodities Act, 1955, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Rewari.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed on 10.09.2018: -

“.....Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, on receiving a secret information that the petitioners and other accused persons are storing diesel by taking the same from the diesel tanker driver and are illegally supplying the same at Rajasthan at cheaper rate from the market, a raid was conducted and 03 persons have already been arrested and recovery has been effected whereas the petitioners were not found at the spot.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ajit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 10.09.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
