This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P.C. for grant of bail pending trial or in the alternative for interim bail in case FIR No.63 dated 04.05.2018 under Sections 307, 353, 186, 332, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Shambu, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner restricts the present petition only qua the relief of interim bail; since the wife of the petitioner has given birth to male child on 17.09.2018. The petitioner would be required to accompany his wife and the newly born.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by HC Mohar Singh, submits that the factum of the birth of child by the wife of the petitioner has been verified and the statement of wife of the petitioner was also recorded in this regard. The fact of giving birth to the baby by the wife of the petitioner has been found to be correct.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed qua interim bail only. The petitioner is granted concession of interim bail, for period of one month from the date of his actual release. He be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing

bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate,
concerned.

It is further ordered that the petitioner shall surrender before the
trial Court on expiry of one month from the date of his release.
