1 Petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR no.55 dated 01.07.2018, registered at Police Station Bahavwala, Abohar, District Fazilka, Punjab, under Sections 22 and 62 of NDPS Act, 1985.

2 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the investigation in this case is complete and the alleged recovery made from the petitioner is of non-commercial quantity. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. Thus, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody indefinitely and there is no other criminal case is pending against the petitioner. The petitioner deserve to be released on regular bail.

3. The aforementioned factual submissions are not disputed by the learned State counsel.

4 In view of the above, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

5 Accordingly, petition is allowed and the petitioner-Surinder

Kumar is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
