**AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

By this petition, FIR No.27 dated 05.02.2017, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Dehlon, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 379-B of the IPC, is sought to be quashed, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioner (accused) and respondent no. 2, i.e. the complainant. A copy of the deed of compromise has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

Pursuant to the order dated 01.02.2018, a report of the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, has been received, to the effect that the statement of the complainant (respondent no.2 herein) Kamaldeep Singh, was recorded by that Court, as was that of the petitioner (Pritpal Singh), in support of the compromise reached between the parties,

As per the assessment of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, the compromise arrived at appeared to be genuine at the own volition of the parties.

Consequently, the allegation against the petitioner being one of snatching a motor cycle of the complainant, with the complainant having settled the matter with the petitioner, and it not being shown that the petitioner has any other criminal case registered against him, the petition is allowed and FIR No.27 dated 05.02.2017, registered at Police Station Dehlon, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 379-B of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
