By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.54 dated 5.7.2014 registered under Sections 452, 447, 511, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Maloudh, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 10.9.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Ekam Singh, Surinder Singh, Sukhpal Singh @ Sukha, Gagandeep Singh, Jasveer Singh, Sukhpreet Singh, Jatinder Duggal and Harinder Singh @ Kiran as well as of complainant Sukhvir Singh have been

recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.54 dated 5.7.2014 registered under Sections 452, 447, 511, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Maloudh, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
