GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.199 dated 18.12.2017 under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 01.02.2018 the parties had been directed to

appear before the Illaqa Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sunam has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners-Harpreet Singh, Gurbhej Singh, Atma Singh, Shishpal, Harmeet Singh and Harmeet Singh son of Jawala as well as of Ranjodhveer Singh-complainant have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant-Ranjodhveer Singh has no objection if the FIR is quashed against the accused. It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sunam, that the parties have arrived at compromise with their free volition, without any inducement, threat, promise, coercion or undue influence from any quarter.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.199 dated 18.12.2017 under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
