In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.336 dated 20.08.2017, under Sections 379-B IPC (charge-sheeted under Sections 395, 412, 392 read with 397 IPC) registered at Police Station Sadar Sonapat, District Sonapat.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is in custody since 19.12.2017. It was also submitted that complainant has been examined in the trial. No purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar as trial of the case would take some time. Co-accused has already been admitted to bail vide order dated 20.07.2018 passed in CRM-M-18789-2018.

3. On instructions of ASI Sunil, learned State counsel has not disputed the above factual aspects.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 19.12.2017 and co-accused has already

been granted bail and disposal of the trial will take sufficient time, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

6. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Deepak is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

7. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.

8. Petition stands allowed.
