Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.78 dated 07.06.2018 registered under Sections 307, 506, 427, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Memorandum of appearance filed on behalf of the complainant in court today, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 11.09.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.
