In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail in case FIR No.56 dated 19.06.2018 under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that there is a civil dispute between the petitioner and the complainant and others. In order to harass the petitioner, complaint has been filed by the complainant which has resulted in filing of FIR. Perusal of the allegations stated in the FIR, it is evident that petitioner is alleged to have cheated the complainant in respect of money transaction. Huge amount of Rs.30,20,313/- is involved in the present FIR and recovery of the same is yet to be effected. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case so as to extend him the benefit of anticipatory bail.

3.) Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
