This order shall dispose of above mentioned two petitions bearing Nos. CRM-M-39572-2018 titled as **Lakhan and others versus State of Haryana** and CRM-M-44688-2018 titled as **Sucha Versus State of Haryana**. For brevity the facts are being taken from CRM-M-39572-2018.

Petitioners namely *Lakhan, Dimpu, Ramu and Sandeep* in CRM-M-39572-2018 and petitioner namely *Sucha* in CRM-M-44688-2018 seek regular bail in cross-version under Section 148,149, 324, 452, 506 of the Indian Penal Code in case FIR No. 878 dated 21.7.2018 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Karnal (Annexure P-1 colly).

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that Section 326 of the Indian Penal Code was added later on.

It comes out that petitioners were arrested on 11.8.2018 and since then they are in custody.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sajjan Singh, submits that challan has been presented on 13.11.2018 and the next date of hearing is fixed for 7.12.2018. All the offences are triable by the Magistrate.

Since the disposal of the trial will take time, therefore, there is no ground for further detention of the petitioners. Accordingly, both the petitions are allowed and the petitioners namely *Lakhan, Dimpu, Ramu and Sandeep in CRM-M-39572-2018* and petitioner namely *Sucha in CRM-M-44688-2018* are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- each with one surety of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to following conditions: -

- (1) Petitioners shall surrender their passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioners shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioners shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of their absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel their bail.

Petitions stand allowed accordingly.
