There is no material indicating any threat or provocation in the intervening period of 12 days between 30th July, 2017 as specified in the FIR and the actual date of the victim's death (11th August, 2017), which was sought to be considered as noted in the earlier order dated 22nd November, 2017.

It is also strange that certain vital though undated document maintained in the Case Diary has not yet been referred for examination by the Expert.

In the given circumstances considering the available material in the Case Diary the interim bail granted to the petitioner is confirmed.
