Kuldeep Singh, J. (Oral)

One Pawan Kumar committed suicide in Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh, leaving note, in which, he alleged that he had taken Rs.10 lakhs from Sandeep Kumar, Dealer and present petitioner Charanjit Singh, which they converted into Rs.20 lakhs. Even though he returned Rs.7 lakhs but they have threatened to kill him. Therefore, he is committing suicide. On the basis of the said suicide note, a case under Section 306 IPC was registered bearing FIR No.68 dated 29.4.2016. Petitioner was arrested on 26.10.2017. Challan has been presented. Wife of the petitioner has been examined and his son is stated to have been given up. The disposal of the case will take time. Since material witness has been examined and disposal of case will take time, therefore there is no justification in keeping the petitioner in detention.

Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court, subject to such conditions as may be imposed by the trial Court.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
