Report dated 16.11.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Rubal Kanda and the accused persons, namely, Gurpreet Singh and Harpal Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of**

Punjab and another' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and 'Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 46 dated 14.06.2018 registered at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar under Sections 406/498-A IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
