RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 159 dated 10.06.2017, under Sections 323, 341 427, 506, 34 of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 19.02.2018 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 11.09.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana and got recorded their statements qua compromise on

25.09.2018. Report from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, vide letter No. 284 dated 03.10.2018, duly forwarded by learned District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, vide Endst. No. 898/EC dated 05.10.2018, has been received. According to the report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, the compromise is genuine and it is voluntarily effected between the parties with their free consent and without any pressure, threat, coercion or undue influence from any side.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR No. 159 dated 10.06.2017, under Sections 323, 341, 427, 506, 34 of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners only is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana, High Court, Rs. 1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with High Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
