The petitioner is aggrieved because despite representation dated 27.08.2018 (Annexure P1), the official respondents are not taking any action against the private respondents, who are forcibly trying to dispossess her from her property. She is also being threatened.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 9, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P1) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is found necessary, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Meanwhile, it shall be ensured that no harm comes to the petitioner.
