HARI PAL VERMA, J.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the impugned order dated 21.03.2015 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar, whereby the petitioner has been declared as a proclaimed person in a complaint case filed against him by respondent No.2-complainant under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that as against the cheque amount of Rs.24 lakh, the petitioner has already paid a sum of Rs.10 lakh to the respondent No.2-complainant and is ready to make the remaining payment of the cheque amount. He has produced an affidavit of even date furnished by the petitioner, wherein it has been stated that the petitioner is ready to pay the remaining amount of Rs.14 lakh within a period of six months. The affidavit is taken on record.

Be that as it may, but taking into consideration the limited prayer made in the petition, whereby quashing of the order declaring the petitioner as proclaimed person has been sought for, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from today, he shall be admitted on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trail Court subject to payment of Rs.10,000/- as costs to be deposited by the petitioner with the District Legal Services Authority, Rupnagar.
