This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 307, 452, 324, 323, 294, 295, 506, 148 & 149 IPC, Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, Sections 3 & 4 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Section 67 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana, vide FIR No.296 dated 19.9.2017.

Learned State counsel submits that pursuant to order dated October 13, 2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated October 13, 2017 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
