The mother, brother and sister in law of the petitioner have allegedly set up a Will, which has been challenged by the petitioner by way of a civil suit. An FIR has also been registered against them for criminal trespass. The grievance of the petitioner is that her relatives in collusion with the police, are trying to force her to withdraw from prosecuting the FIR. Further, the police in collusion with her relatives, is not investigating the FIR in an un-biased manner. Representations dated 23.07.2018 (Annexure P3), 13.08.2018 (Annexure P2) and 02.09.2018 (Annexure P7) have been submitted, but to no avail.
