Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.101 dated 21.06.2012, registered under Sections 302, 201 IPCat Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Khanna.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has already surrendered before the learned trial court and has been granted interim bail by that court.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 02.02.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
