The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.112 dated 30.09.2016, under Sections 498-A, 406, 341, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein contends that while issuing the notice of motion on 07.11.2016, the petitioner herein has been granted interim anticipatory bail. It is submitted that during the pendency of this petition, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court, however, the mediation was not successful. It is thereafter, the parties appeared before the Panchayat, where the matter was

settled amicably and in terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties, a petition for divorce has already been filed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of complainant-respondents No.2 admits to the factum of settlement that has been arrived at between the parties and does not oppose to the confirmation of interim anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the facts that the petitioner herein has joined the investigation and the matter stands amicably settled between the parties, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 07.11.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
