Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438

Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.104 dated 15.03.2017, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506, 325 and 326 IPC (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added later) at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jamshed, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 13.10.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
