This order shall dispose of CRM No.M-38826 of 2017
(Dayal Singh @ Ramandeep Singh Vs. State of Punjab), CRM No.M-
33271 of 2017 (Navdeep Singh @ Rambo Vs. State of Punjab) and
CRM No.M-34159 of 2017 (Maninder Singh Vs. State of Punjab) as

these three connected petitions have been preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners herein in case FIR No.38 dated 15.03.2017, under Sections 379B, 323, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, Distrit Sri Muktsar Sahib.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Ravinder Pawan Kumar.

Allegations are that on 14.03.2017 while the complainant was proceeded on a scooter, he was accosted by one Sham Lal @ Shama as also the present petitioners. A purse containing Rs.1100/- as also driving licence/other papers were snatched. That apart complainant alleges that he was also assaulted. An iron rod blow on the back was attributed to co-accused Sham Lal @ Shama. Dayal Singh @ Ramandeep Singh i.e. the petitioner in CRM No.M-38826 of 2017 was attributed a brick blow on the left side of the forehead of the complainant. Maninder Singh @ Bitta i.e. petitioner in CRM No.M-34159 of 2017 was alleged to have armed with a baseball and inflicted baseball blows on the thighs of both the legs and Navdeep Singh @ Rambo i.e. petitioner in CRM No.M-33271 of 2017 is alleged to have twisted the fingers of the left hand of the complainant.

State counsel upon instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh apprises the Court that the injuries allegedly suffered by the complainant have been opined to be simple in nature.

Co-accused Sham Lal @ Shama (non-applicant) is stated to have been arrested and thereafter granted benefit of

regular bail.

Further more in view of the orders passed by this Court the petitioners herein are stated to have already joined investigation.

Under such circumstances, the prayer made in these petitions is accepted.

Order dated 03.11.2017 passed in CRM No.M-38826 of 2017, order dated 21.09.2017 passed in CRM N.M-34159 of 2017 and order dated 07.09.2017 passed in CRM No.M-33271 of 2017 are made absolute.
